- Class #1: Maple Syrup – Ontario Grade A Golden- 2-250 ml Curved Kent Bottles
- Class #2: Maple Syrup – Ontario Grade A Amber – 2- 250 ml Curved Kent Bottles
- Class #3: Maple Syrup – Ontario Grade A Dark - 2 – 250 ml Curved Kent Bottles
- Class #4: Stirred Maple Sugar 1- 250 ml Jar
- Class #5: Maple Sugar Soft 1- 125 gram box (10 small pieces)
- Class #6: Maple Butter 1- 250 ml Jar
- Class #7: Value Added Basket – The Marion Paul Memorial Award – 1 Basket

*Based on the highest points of the first place maple syrup in classes one through three the Lanark and District Maple Syrup Producers Association provides a keeper trophy for the **Champion Maple Syrup.** Prize Money is provided by the Perth Chamber of Commerce Festival of the Maple Committee.*

Presentation of Awards: The Trophies will be awarded on the Saturday April 27, 2024, at 10:30 am, at the Main Stage following the Opening Ceremonies. Winners will be contacted on Friday evening and should be present to receive their award.

Best Sales Display Booth Competition: Vendors Maple Sales Booths will be judged on Saturday morning starting at 8: 30 am, based on the following criteria: Educational Value; Promotion of the Maple Industry; Suitability of containers and packaging in regards with the Provincial Regulations and Overall attractiveness of the Display.

The Hal Botham Memorial Trophy will be presented for the Best Sales Display Booth.

RULES & REGULATIONS: POINTS OF REFERENCE

1. Maple Syrup and Products will be judged on the following basis:

Champion Maple Syrup will be judged on Density, Clarity and Flavour using the first-place maple syrup from Classes 1,2 & 3.

2. Maple Syrup under “66 Brix” or over “68.9 Brix” will be disqualified.
3. Exhibits in classes 1,2 & 3 shall consist of 2- 250 ml Curved Kent bottles.
4. An exhibitor may only enter one exhibit per class. Syrup and products to be made in the current year by the Producer or their family.

6. Exhibits must be received no later than Noon on **Wednesday April 24, 2024** at St. Andrew’s Presbyterian Church, 1 Drummond St. West (corner of North and Drummond St.’s) Watch for signs at Drummond St door. **Doors Open 9 am, until Noon.**
7. All entries must be accompanied by an entry fee of **\$5.00** for each class entered. Cheques payable to L&DMSPA.
8. The use of labels or any other marking that might serve to identify the exhibitor will not be permitted. All syrup should be hot packed and sealed.
9. Please clearly mark each container as to the class you wish to have it compete in. Grade sticker on the bottom of container is acceptable. Any entry improperly classified will be disqualified.
10. Entries may be claimed by the exhibitors between 4:00- 4:30 p.m. on Saturday April 27, 2024, at the L&DMSPA Display. Any unclaimed entries become the property of the L&DMSPA. Entries will be on display to the public, as space allows, the day of the Festival.
